AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned, Tabana, having been warned to state the truth and that I shall be subject to the penalties prescribed by law should I fail to do so, hereby state and declare in writing as follows:

- 1. I arrived at the interrogation facility in Ashkelon Prison on March 10, 1996. I was detained in Hebron on March 3, 1996.
- 2. On March 11, 1996 I was shaken by my interrogators: once during the day and once at night. When I was shaken during the day three interrogators were present in the interrogation room. At night there was only one interrogator.

My interrogators told me that they would do to me what they had done to Abdel Samed Harizat. They also told me that I would leave prison in a wheelchair. My clothes are torn.

- 3. I was ordered to stay in a cold room for a long time.
- 4. My interrogators force me to kneel for long periods of time.
- 5. I would also like to point out that in addition to the day-time shaking, one of the interrogators pushed my head forcefully into a desk.
- 6. I was shaken with my hands and legs cuffed.
- 7. My head aches.
- 8. My head is covered with a sack for long periods of time.
- 9. Since I arrived to Ashkelon my interrogators do not let me sleep. When I am not being interrogated I am in the "shabach" position.
- 10. My hands are swollen from the cuffs. My ankles are also swollen.
- 11. When I entered Ashkelon Prison I did not undergo any physical examination by a physician. I was only asked if I had any problems.
- 12. After the content of my affidavit was translated into Arabic, I declare that this is my name, this is my signature and the content of my affidavit is true.
